b) Call in progress conversations last month, good turn out for that
c) After spring break the school will be in a departmental review
a. Meeting on April $12^{\text {th }}$
b. Self assessment of how the different programs are running for children with complex needs and they will put together a report after
d) April $8^{\text {th }}$ the school will be presenting at the school board meeting to review their wellness program
e) Spring musical mid April
a. Put a post to see if there are any parents willing to come help with costumes
b. The kids are really enjoying it so far
f) Lots of field trips planned for after April
g) Staffing numbers needed for next year will be available at the end of the week and the school will start planning
a. So far sitting at 2 English kindergarten classes and 1 French kindergarten class, this will be the first year in about 10 years that there will only be 1 French class
b. The 2 English classes are already at low 20s and they will assess at 25 kids and determine if they will split it, possibly look at a split class (ex. 3/4)
c. So far no teachers have indicated that they are retiring
