Business Arising:

- a) Purdy's Chocolate
 - a. Order Forms went out last Friday

- b) Staff Appreciation- Amanda
 - a. Budget was \$600 but after discussing with a caterer it was going to be ~\$12/head, will be Abby McLeod again
 - b. Motion to increase budget to \$850- all were in favour
 - c. Week will be broken down like this:

 - iv. 21st Staff lunch
 - v. 22nd Beach day
- c) February 9th Valentines Dance
 - a. Was a big hit and everyone had a really great time
 - i. Had one negative comment but otherwise really good feedback
 - b. Hit capacity at 6:15 and most people were understanding that we had to turn them away
 - i. Was able to let most people in who waited around after a bit
 - c. Was tough to find the custodian after to clean up

 - d. Amanda put a motion forward to pay for half (\$1,300)- all were in favour
