- o The school will get compensated for the use of the yard and school
- Festival de Voyager
  - Going to do more classroom based activities
  - Will have a dress up day
  - o Some of the grades 3 & 4 classes will be going to Festival
- Progress conversations at the end of February
- Final infographic is currently at the printers
  - o Includes all the mental math expectations for students
- Wellness assembly on Jan 30<sup>th</sup>
  - o Discussing expected behaviors in the winter months
  - o Kids will do some scenarios and case studies to work through some of the issues
