 - Will add in learnings about a leap year and the science behind it
- Movie being filmed at the school
 - Went well and got lots of pictures
 - Brought it in all the snow for it
 - Hoping for the movie to be a classic Christmas movie

- Had to film in the school because of how cold it was outside and they couldn't do the scenes outside
- The school will get compensated for the use of the yard and school
- Festival de Voyager
 - Going to do more classroom based activities
 - Will have a dress up day
 - Some of the grades 3 & 4 classes will be going to Festival
- Progress conversations at the end of February
- Final infographic is currently at the printers
 - Includes all the mental math expectations for students
- Wellness assembly on Jan 30th
 - Discussing expected behaviors in the winter months
 - Kids will do some scenarios and case studies to work through some of the issues
 - Tying it into Mastery in the wellness circle
 - School division has hired an Elder to work with the schools
 - April 8th the School will be presenting to the board the work that is being done in regards to wellness and regulation
